What would be the initial aims of the Foundation?

At the start the Foundation would be administered by a Foundation Officer, overseen by Remco Weeda, whose initial remit would be to gather together all those from the groups above onto one platform that would allow for more efficient communications across the Foundation community.

Bringing together the community through events and communications will be the number one aim at the beginning of the Foundations life.

We want all those with any connection to the College to feel 'connected' and continue to be a part of the family that is Scarborough College – something that we know that the OSA has been doing for many years, but we now want to bring everyone together.

What would be the future aims of the Foundation?

Like so many independent schools that do not have access to an historic endowment fund, Scarborough College will be more reliant upon funds generated through its Foundation to help with increasing needs for bursaries and scholarships as well as help with capital projects.

The Foundation would give a platform for those that would like to help and give back to the school, through a range of opportunities and specific forms of giving both in the present and in the future.

How would the Foundation work alongside the OSA?

The OSA would continue to do its work with regards to reunions and communications with Old Scardeburgians but there would be the added support of the Foundation Officer to help with the organisation of events and with communications with OS – with the new platform allowing for more targeted communications when required.

The OSA will not lose its name, function or its decision- making power over funds raised.
